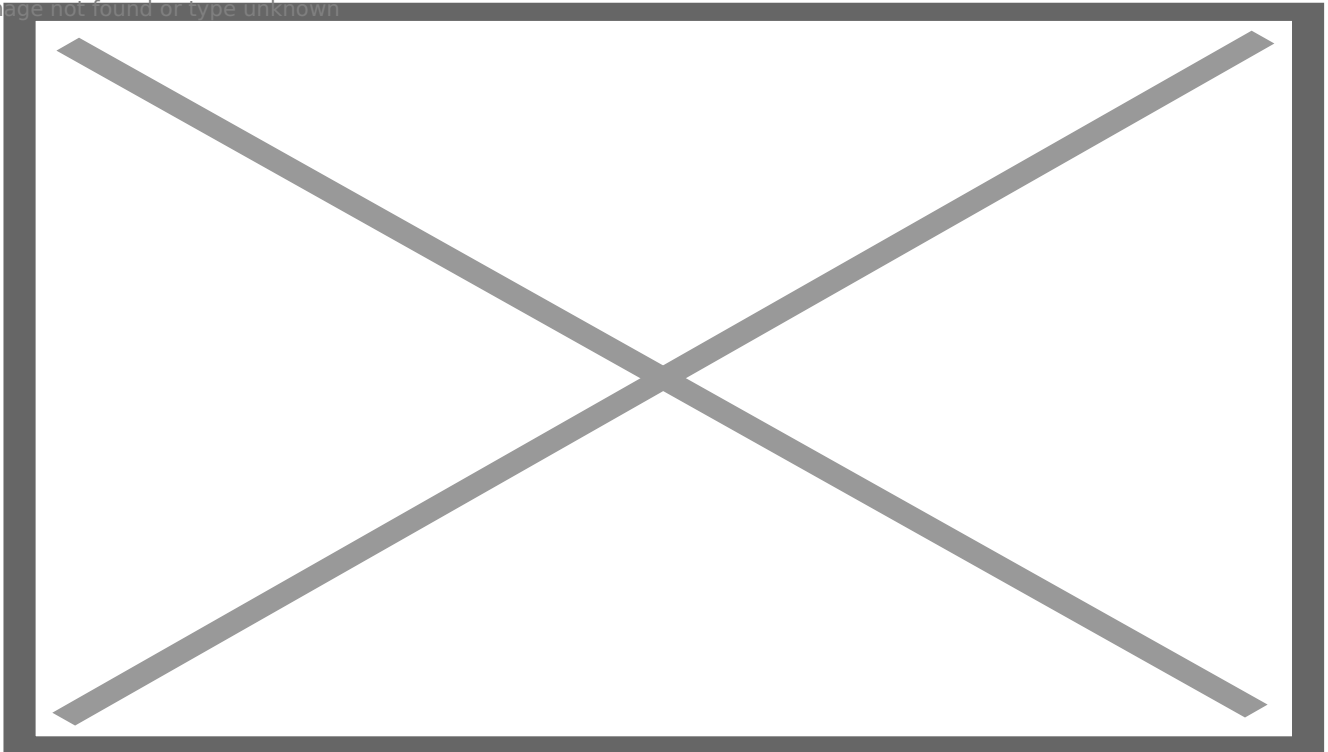


# Law students spend spring break helping former Eric C. Conn clients
