AppalReD Legal Aid's Legal Services for Veterans (LSV) helps veterans who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. Our attorneys provide monthly drop-in clinics at the VA clinics in Somerset, Hazard, and Berea. AppalReD receives direct referrals from the VA system in Lexington since members of outlying counties often use medical services in Lexington. Attorneys are available to meet with veterans who live in AppalReD's service region in Lexington on the VA campus on request.

AppalReD Legal Aid serves low-income veterans and members of the military, no matter their discharge status, who reside in 37 counties across eastern and south-central Kentucky. We take pride in serving those who served.

Please call 1-866-277-5733 to complete an income eligibility screening and for us to learn more about your civil legal issue.


