At the session, tenants will be paired with an attorney to go over their documents and help them develop a strategy to try to resolve the issue without an eviction ever being filed.

We can address any landlord/tenant issue, but it is limited to tenants who have been served with a Notice to Vacate but who have not been served with a forcible detainer action.
